### Day 1: Dar / Zanzibar – Selous

### Day 2: Selous

Countless elephants and buffaloes, prides of lions, giraffes, zebras and impalas are quite common. Selous is also quite famous for having many African wild dogs.

### Day 3: Dar / Zanzibar

Dawn Walking Safari & Drive to Dar Es Salaam

# 04 | Day Trip: Fly-In Mikumi National Park

## Full Itinerary

### Day Trip: Zanzibar - Mikumi - Zanzibar

Departing From hotel at 5:15am then flight is at 07:00hrs to Mikumi national park on your arrival in Mikumi Airstrip at 08:10hrs, The driver guide who will brief you regarding your game drive in Mikumi.

After a short brief you will depart for a game drive in a 4x4 modified safari vehicle in the Mikumi national park exploring the game in the surrounding areas, from your seat on an open-sided vehicle, a comfortable and privileged journey through the wild African bush. You may expect to see any of the major African great favorite mammals, including elephant, giraffes, lions, buffalo, zebra and Leopard.

Picnic lunch shall be provided in the mid-day where by your guide will select a location with shade and water nearby to watch animals coming to drink - a place with a clear view all round so that no predator can creep up hidden.

### Departure

Late in the afternoon, you will be transferred to the airstrip for your scheduled flight at 16:00hrs to Zanzibar arriving at 50:10hrs.

### Day 1: Zanzibar – Serengeti

Morning flight from Zanzibar (via Arusha) to the Serengeti National Park with arrival early afternoon. Pick up from the Seronera Airstrip by your guide. On the way to the camp, you go on your first game drive around Serengeti. Reach at your luxury tented camp just before the sun sets over the vast Serengeti Plains. Overnight at Lodge or Camp. Lunchbox and Dinner

### Day 2: Serengeti

Early morning game drive to see also nocturnal predators returning from hunting and animals waking up in early morning light followed by a day of game drives at the Great Serengeti, likely the most famous wildlife sanctuary in the world. Depending on the time of year and the migration of the herds you can expect to see wildebeest, lions, elephants, giraffes, zebras, monkeys, baboons, hippos, rhinos, antelopes and many birds and other species. In the afternoon you can go on a Nature Walk around your camp (included in the package price). Also, a night game drive can be arranged for you (at extra cost, 50 – 60 USD pp.). Overnight at Lodge or Camp. Full Board.

### Day 3: Serengeti – Zanzibar

After a Bush breakfast we take you to the nearest airstrip in the Serengeti, for your flight back to Zanzibar (approx. 10:00 – 14:20 h). Breakfast and lunchbox included.

# 06 | 3 Days, 2 Nights: Tarangire NP, Manyara NP & Ngorongoro

## Full Itinerary

### Day 1 Arusha – Lake Manyara

In the morning you'll drive across the floor of the Great Rift Valley to Lake Manyara National Park. This beautiful park with its lush vegetation and tropical forests of giant fig and mahogany trees, takes its name from the Masai word for "euphorbia tirucalli", a bush which is used to make a thorny hedge to protect their cattle. Elephant, giraffe, buffalo, zebra and a variety of antelope inhabit the park as well as a variety of monkeys and a large population of hippos. If you are lucky, you may see the Manyara lions, well known for their tree climbing habits, lazily resting on the branches of an "Acacia tortilis" tree. The birdlife is also abundant with flamingos, pelicans, hornbills and plenty of forest species.

Driving time without game viewing 2 – 2, 5 hours  
overnight at Lodge Packed lunch and dinner.

### Day 2 Ngorongoro

After leisurely breakfast you travel towards Ngorongoro. En-route visit of the lively market of Karatu. Around 11:00 hrs. You reach Ngorongoro Conservation Area home of the world famous Ngorongoro Crater. It is the world's largest intact volcanic caldera and a natural sanctuary for some of Africa's densest animal populations and one of the few places where the rare black rhino can be observed in its natural habitat. Time without game viewing approx. -2 hours.

Overnight at Camp Full board

### Day 3 Tarangire National Park – Arusha

Your private safari ends with the drive to Tarangire, Tanzania's fifth largest national park and sanctuary for an unusually large elephant population. Majestic baobab trees are an interesting feature of the park, dwarfing the animals that feed beneath them. Animals concentrate along the Tarangire River, which provides the only permanent water supply in the area. There is a great diversity of wildlife including lion, leopard and cheetah and up to six thousand elephants.

Return to Arusha after finishing your game drive.

Driving time without game viewing 2, 5 hours. Breakfast and packed lunch included.

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# 07 | 3 Days, 2 Nights: Budget Safari Drive-In Mikumi

## Full Itinerary

### Day 1: Dar es Salaam/ Zanzibar – Mikumi National Park

Pick up from Dar Es Salaam Airport or ferry terminal or your hotel in Dar Es Salaam City (pick up at the South Beaches with a supplement) by Zagaz Explorer Driver guide and leave for Mikumi National Park, being nestled between the Uluguru Mountains to the East and the Rift Valley Escarpments to the Southwest. As it is close to the Selous ecosystem and therefore part of it, it benefits from the highest game density of the entire conservation area. The Mikumi National Park obtains a good impression of the African animal world and is suitable very well for a short visit. After arrival at Mikumi National Park you go on game drives around the park.

Driving time without game drives 4-5 hours.

Overnight at Lodge. Packed lunch included.

### Day 2: Mikumi National Park

Full day of game drives around Mikumi. There is a rich variety bird species as well as large numbers of giraffes, buffaloes and elephants and close to the water holes also lions, leopards and hippos. Furthermore, you can see zebras, lions, wild dogs, pythons, hartebeest, wildebeest, elephants, impala, warthog, eland and other antelopes. Mikumi National Park is mostly miombo woodland with gently rolling hills.

Overnight at Lodge. Breakfast and packed lunch included.

### Day 3: Mikumi – Dar es Salaam

Early morning game drives at Mikumi to see also nocturnal animals not to be seen during the day. After late breakfast you return to Dar es Salaam with arrival in the afternoon / early evening (depending on your schedule). Breakfast and packed lunch included.

## Full Itinerary

### Day 1: Dar es Salaam / Zanzibar – Ruaha National Park

Morning flight from Dar es Salaam or Zanzibar to Ruaha National Park, the largest national park of Tanzania. You will be picked up from Ruaha Airstrip and transferred to your lodge for lunch and a meeting with the lodge manager to discuss your program for the afternoon and following days. Afterwards you go on a first game drive around Ruaha. Your comfortable lodge constructed around a rocky kopje overlooking the Great Ruaha River. It provides comfortable accommodation and good food while blending into its surroundings to enable visitors to feel themselves a part of the wild. Both the dining “Banda” and the bar, in elevated position above the river combine comfort and coolness together with the most spectacular views.

Overnight at Lodge. Lunch and dinner included.

### Day 2: Ruaha National Park

You spend a full day at Ruaha National Park, one of Tanzania's best kept wildlife secrets. Previously inaccessibility has ensured being unaffected by the ravages of mankind. It is the country's biggest elephant sanctuary and formed by the Great Ruaha River flowing along its eastern border creating spectacular gorges. The Ruaha National Park is home to hippo and crocodile, waterbuck, reedbuck, buffaloes, lions, leopards, hyenas, wild dogs, jackals and many elephants. Best time to visit is the dry season from May to December where animals are concentrated around the shrinking water courses. Overnight at Lodge. Full board

### Day3: Ruaha – Departure

In the morning you proceed with your safari activities until it is time for your transfer back to the airstrip for your return flight to Dar es Salaam or Zanzibar. Breakfast and (packed lunch) included.

## Full Itinerary

The area lying between Mount Kilimanjaro and Eastern Arc Mountains is rich in wildlife and cultural heritage of local tribes that together have formed unique and beautiful scenery that is a must not miss visit for travelers visiting Africa for grassroots' experience. Set below the verdant slope of the spectacular Usambara and Pare Eastern Arc Mountain ranges and overseen by iconic snowcapped peak of Kilimanjaro, Mkomazi is a virgin breath taking beauty exhibiting unique natural treasures and immense sense of space. ### Day 2: Mkomazi – Lake Chala / Marangu

After early breakfast, drive to Lake Chala arriving in time for 2-3 hours walking to the view point of the lakes and down to the lake as well as kayaking excursions at the lake. Later on, hot lunch at the lodge and then proceeds to Marangu at your hotel arriving in time for leisure, dinner and overnight,

### Day 3: Marangu – Day Trip to Mandara Hut

After breakfast, transfer to Marangu Gate for the Mountain Climb Registration and begin your day trip Kilimanjaro trekking by walking along a narrow trail through the rainforest of Kilimanjaro for most of the hike, you will proceed with your walking through the rainforest until reaching Mandara Hut where you will have your lunch.
